

UPDATED Quarantine Protocols for COVID-19

Below are the updated quarantine and safety protocols for Woodcrest School. These protocols have been aligned to meet the standards of the LA County Department of Public Health.

As COVID-19 varients and case loads change, along with updated guidance by the LA County Department of Public Health, Woodcrest School will revise and adjust the protocols appropriately.

Students & Staff Who Test Positive for COVID-19

(regardless of vaccination status)

- -Self-isolate for 5 days
- -On day 5 if you have remained asymptomatic and have been fever free for the previous 24 hours, they can take an Antigen COVID-
- If you receive a negative test result, they may return to school on Day 6 but must wear a medical grade mask for 5 days as long as symptoms are improving.
- -If the test returns postive after day 5, stay home an additional 5

- Self-isolate for 10 days and return on Day 11 without testing (as long as fever-free and asymptomatic for 24 hours) prior to return.

Students & Staff Showing The Following Symptoms (Regardless of Vaccinaton Status)

Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing, Fatique, Muscle or Body Aches, Headache, New Loss of Taste or Smell, Sore Throat, Congestion or Runny Nose, Nausea or Vomiting, Diarrhea

- -If an individual is showing symptoms they will be required to stay home and/or be picked up from school and be required take an Antigen COVID-19 Test.
- -If the test is negative, they may return to school once they are symptom free.
- -If the Antigen COVID-19 test is positive, they will follow our COVID-19 quarantine guidance (see above).
 - *Please note that LACDPH and our guidelines are still subject to change from unforeseen circumstances that may arise in the future.

Students & Staff Who Are a Household Contact of a Positive Case of COVID-19

(regardless of vaccination status)

- Monitor your for symptoms of COVID. You are encouraged to take an Antigen COVID-19 Test.
- -If you are non-symptomatic and test NEGATIVE, you may attend school/work as scheduled.
- -If you are unable to quarantine the individual who has tested positive stay home for 5 days and quarantine.
- *A photo of the negative test will need to be provided to the school office. Note: Day 0 is the day the test sample was taken or the onset of symptoms.

While masks remain optional, we respect everyone's personal decisions and choice regarding their decision on wearing one.
